

- *NFP REPORT = New jobs report 1st Friday of every month.
- *PPI REPORT = Measures the change of goods sold by manufacturers (INFLATION)
- *CPI REPORT = Measures the change in the price of goods and services from the perspective of the consumer (INFLATION)
- *INITIAL JOBLESS CLAIMS = Americans filing for unemployment Thurs-Thurs
- *CORE RETAIL SALES = Measures the change in the total value of sales at the retail level
- *CB CONSUMER CONFIDENCE = Measures the level of consumer confidence in economic activity
- *ISM MANUFACTURING REPORT = Business data from all U.S. businesses
- *FED INTEREST RATE DECISION = (FOMC) members vote on where to set the rate. (currency valuation)
- *GDP REPORT = Measures the annualized change in the

inflation-adjusted value of all goods and services produced by our economy
